Ash Wednesday is the Church's solemn call to keep the season of Lent. We accept this call, united with those preparing for baptism at Easter, and recalling our own baptism as we enter this special time of prayer and penitence. Lent is not simply a time of personal devotion and renewal. It is a time of community renewal as we seek to renew our hearts and souls together. Ashes are blessed and distributed at Mass. These ashes will be ritually washed away in the new waters of the Easter Vigil.

Lent & Eastertide is an ideal time for us to grow in the faith. This year we will follow "Sycamore", an informal course about the Christian faith and its relevance for life today. The course is designed to give you space to meet other people, share ideas, explore your beliefs, and think about questions that really matter. The focus of these film-based sessions is on knowing God and the salvation he offers in Jesus Christ (Film 2, 4 and 5), and on our response to this offer of salvation in faith, freedom and love (Films, 7, 9 and 10). We will continue our gatherings into Eastertide this year to share our experiences of celebrating the Resurrection of the Lord.

- 1. The Existence of God 9th March. Why bother thinking about religion? Five reasons not to believe in God. Arguments for the existence of God?
- 2. Who is Jesus? 16th March. He came to bring life to the world. The Saving Death of Jesus. The light of the Resurrection.
- 3. The Holy Spirit & the Church 23rd March. How the Holy Spirit can change your life. No one gets into heaven alone. Why we need signs, symbols and sacraments.
- 4. **The Gift of Faith** 30th March. What is faith? Are Christians just stupid or are there good reasons to believe? How to take a step of faith.
- 5. **Finding true Freedom** 13th April. Is there such a thing as right and wrong? Where can we find moral guidance? How do you discover your true identity?
- 6. **The Meaning of Love** 20th April. What is love? How to love your neighbour. Knowing the love of God.
